

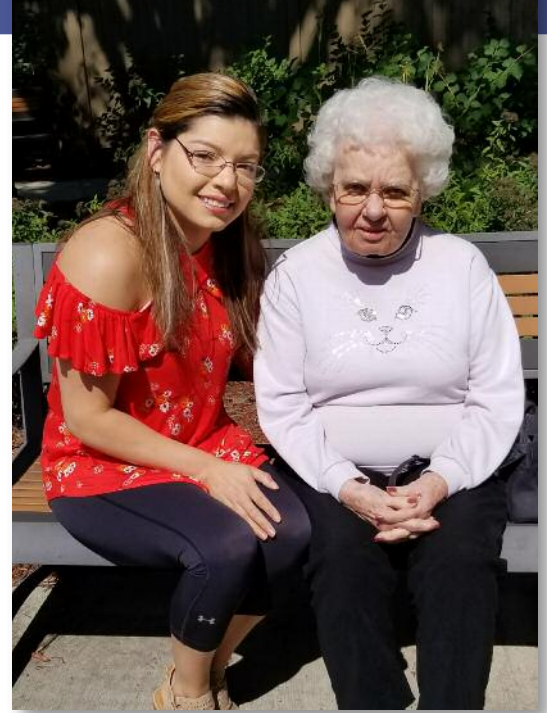
They give support every day. Let's give them ours.
